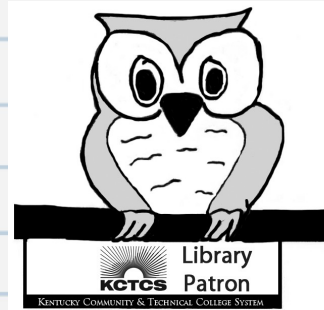

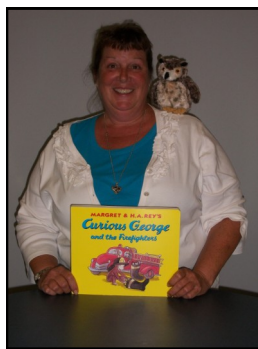

Be sure to order your library materials as early as possible to ensure that funding is still available for purchasing. All divisions share a collective fund. Orders may be placed online using the following link:

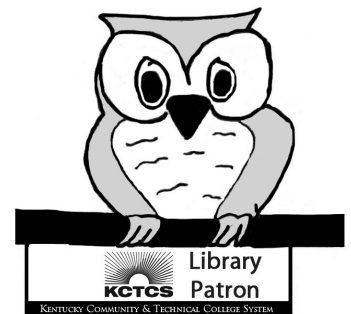
