APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The 2008 - 2009 brochure lists all scholarships available to West Kentucky Community and Technical College students. Please follow the application guidelines below.

- Choose how you wish to apply for WKCTC scholarships: traditional paper application or online application.

WKCTC Paper Application Instructions

- Complete each section of the WKCTC Scholarship Application.
- Your scholarship eligibility is based upon the information provided on the application. Please include as much information as possible.
- Students may elect to complete any or all of the Optional Information section of this application; however, such information may be required to be eligible for specific scholarships. For instance, a student applying for the John T. Smith Scholarship must indicate his or her race to be considered. The WKCTC Scholarship Office is not responsible for notifying applicants as to their eligibility based upon Optional Information provided.
- It is the responsibility of the STUDENT to ensure all required information is received by the WKCTC Scholarship Office by the deadline.
- High School Seniors
 - Have high school counselor complete the Counselor's Verification.
 - Obtain official seventh-semester transcript from high school.
 - Have ACT scores sent to the WKCTC Scholarship Office.

- Your scholarship eligibility is based upon the information provided on the application. Please include as much information as possible.

For instance, a student applying for the John T. Smith Scholarship must indicate his or her race to be considered. The WKCTC Scholarship Office is not responsible for notifying applicants as to their eligibility based upon Optional Information provided.
- It is the responsibility of the STUDENT to ensure all required information is received by the WKCTC Scholarship Office by the deadline.
- High School Seniors
 - You must print the counselor verification form.
 - Take the verification form to your High School Counselor for completion.
 - Obtain official seventh-semester transcript from high school.
 - Have ACT scores sent to the WKCTC Scholarship Office.
 - All information (counselor verification, transcript, ACT) must be received by the WKCTC Scholarship Office by the application deadline.

AUTOMATIC SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

High School Seniors

Current high school seniors are eligible for automatic scholarships at WKCTC if:

1. An ACT score has been received,
2. They meet additional GPA / ACT, class rank or National Merit requirements set below.
3. They are a fulltime student.

KCTCS Commonwealth Scholarship (Full Tuition*)

Available to Valedictorians of any public Kentucky high school (as of seventh semester). This scholarship is renewable for a second consecutive year of study.

National Merit Scholarship (\$2,000)

Available to all National Merit Finalists or Semi-Finalists. This scholarship is renewable for a second consecutive year of study.

Currently Enrolled WKCTC Students

Currently enrolled WKCTC students are eligible for automatic scholarships if:

1. They have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 and above
2. They have completed a minimum of 24 and no more than 35 graded college hours (*PCC and WKTC credits apply. Developmental classes excluded*)
3. They are a full time student

Beiderwell II Scholarship (25% of Full Tuition*)

* Full tuition is considered up to 15 hours. Developmental class are not eligible.

GENERAL and NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Scholarship Criteria:

Current high school seniors are eligible for general and need-based scholarships at WKCTC if:

1. they have a 3.00 cumulative GPA (exceptions noted),
2. they meet the specific scholarship criteria, and they are a fulltime student.

Currently enrolled WKCTC students are eligible for general and need-based scholarships as described if:

1. they have a cumulative collegiate GPA of 3.00 or above, they are a fulltime student.

Award amounts to be determined. Exceptions noted.

D.H. Anderson Scholarship

Available to a technical student who meets the scholarship criteria.

George E. Beiderwell Scholarship

Available to a resident of a Purchase-area county who is a graduate of a western Kentucky high school.

Donald V. Blythe Memorial Scholarship

Available to a student who demonstrates financial need. Preference given surgical technology or African-American students and Kentucky residents.

James C. Bowling Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Dr. Todd Brigrance Memorial Book Scholarship

Available to an allied health student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

Brockenborough Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering (mechanical or chemical) student.

Dr. C. Dale Brown Medical Imaging Scholarship

Available to a radiography student.

Kenny Carpenter Memorial Scouting Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must demonstrate past or present involvement with area scouting organization.

Mary L. Carpenter Scholarship

Available to a female student accepted into the nursing program (RN) who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must have school age children.

Elisha Carter

Available to a graphic communication student.

James T. Carter Scholarship

Available to a student in the humanities field.

Cole Lumber Company Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria. Preference is given to employees, or dependents, of Cole Lumber Co. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.00.*

Donald & Rosella Crecelius Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student or a student accepted into the nursing program (RN). Student must meet the scholarship criteria and demonstrate financial need.

Nat Dortch, Sr. Scholarship

Available to a student studying science or geology.

Gene & Ann Edwards Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student.

Jack Faughn Scholarship

Available to a barbering student.

William A. Feiler Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Good Ole Boys / Russ Chittenden Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student.

Harper Industries, Inc. Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria. Preference given to employees, dependents of employees or deceased employees, and spouses of employees or deceased employees of Harper Industries or any of its subsidiaries. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.00.*

Adoree Haus Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

William G. Haus Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student who graduated from Marshall County High School.

Dr. Leon Higdon Scholarship

Available to a student accepted into the nursing program (RN).

Harry Hogan Trust Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must be a McCracken county resident and graduate of a McCracken county public high school.

Charles L. Humphries Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

ISA - Paducah Section Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering or mechanical engineering student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must be resident of western Kentucky.

Dr. Frank J. Kolb, III Memorial Scholarship

Available to a student in an Allied Health field.

John C. Leeper Scholarship

Available to a pre-chiropractic studies student. *NOTE: Applicant must provide statement of mentorship from a certified chiropractor (contact scholarship office for correct form).*

Dewey & Mary Lineberry Scholarship

Available to a student accepted into the nursing program (RN), or a UK engineering student, who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

Marvin Family Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student.

R.G. "Dean" Matheson Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria. Student must demonstrate leadership ability and participate in extra-curricular activities.

E. Corman Maxie Scholarship

Available to a Paducah Tilghman High School senior who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Preference given to mathematics education, science education, or nursing students (RN or LPN).

McCracken County Medical Alliance Scholarship

Available to a student accepted into an allied health program.

R.C. "Mickey" McGuire, Jr. Scholarship

Available to a licensed Kentucky real estate agent.

Menendez-Moore Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

GENERAL and NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Bernard & Lillian Michelson Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled business student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Applicants are reviewed by the business faculty.

Mildred I. Miller Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Marshall E. Nemer Memorial Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled, non-traditional student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

NewPage Scholarship

Available to a current high school senior who is a dependent of a current employee of NewPage Wickliffe. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.00.*

Vel Lynn Pace Memorial Scholarship

Available to a student who has earned a GED through WKCTC's Adult Education Program.

Paducah Bank Scholarship

Available to a female, single parent, business student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Applicants are reviewed by the business faculty. *NOTE: Employees of Paducah bank and their families are not eligible.*

Paducah River City BPW Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled female student who is active in the workforce and returning to school after raising a family.

Jack Paxton Memorial Scholarship

Available to student graduating from a public or private high schools in the following Kentucky counties: Ballard, Caldwell, Calloway, Carlisle, Crittenden, Fulton, Graves, Hickman, Livingston, Lyon, Marshall, McCracken, and Trigg. Preference given to freshman. Recipient must demonstrate financial need. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.50.*

Steve & Martha Polston Scholarship

Available to a pre-engineering student who is a dependent or grandchild of a LMUS employee. *NOTE: Student must have completed CME 101 or ME101.*

Purchase Cancer Group Scholarship

Available to an allied health program student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must be Kentucky resident.

Richard Ragland Scholarship

Available to a student accepted into the nursing program (RN and LPN) who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

John R. & Opal Reid Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria. Preference given to Reidland High School graduates and descendants of John Barton Reid. *NOTE: Descendants of John Barton Reid should indicate nature of relationship on the Other Information section of the scholarship application.*

Herman J. Robertson Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria. Preference given to chemistry or physics students and graduates of Paducah Tilghman High School.

Elmer & Lottie Robinson Scholarship

Available to a science, electrical technology or electrical engineering student.

GENERAL and NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Rotary Club of Paducah Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must demonstrate activity involvement, awards and honors.

Charles A. Saladino Memorial Scholarship

Available to an incoming freshman who meets the scholarship criteria and is a graduate of a McCracken County high school.

John T. Smith Scholarship

Available to an African-American student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must be a Kentucky resident and demonstrate involvement in extra-curricular activities. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.50. Student must be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours.*

L. David Stacey Memorial Scholarship

Available to an English, music or business student who is a resident of Ballard or McCracken counties.

Clifford W. Sullivan Memorial Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

Ingle L. Tolen Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Upshaw Family Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Western Baptist Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship

Available to a student who is an employee, or dependent of an employee, of Western Baptist Hospital and is accepted into the nursing program (RN).

Western Rivers Corporation

Available to a graduate of a McCracken county public high school who demonstrates leadership abilities.

Ken & Jean Wheeler Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

G. Leon Williams Scholarship

Available to a student in the humanities field.

Williams-Wahl Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Willie M. Wilson Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.

Women's Club of Paducah Scholarship

Available to a female student who is a high school graduate.

WKCTC Scholarship

Available to a legal dependent of an eligible WKCTC employee. Employee must be a current WKCTC employee and have been employed for one year prior to award.

Yaffe Family Scholarship

Awarded to an advanced Culinary Arts student. Student must apply through the Culinary Arts Department.

OTHER SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Scholarship Criteria:

Currently enrolled WKCTC students are eligible for other scholarships if:

1. they have a cumulative collegiate GPA of 3.00 or above,
2. they have completed a minimum of 12 and less than 24 graded college hours at WKCTC by the end of spring semester (*PCC and WKTC credits apply. Developmental classes are included.*)

Award amounts to be determined. Exceptions noted.

George E. Beiderwell Scholarship

Available to a resident of a Purchase-area county who is a graduate of a western Kentucky high school.

Leadership Paducah Scholarship

Available to residents of McCracken, Ballard, Carlisle, Graves, Marshall, Livingston and Massac counties. Must be at least 21 years of age, have completed minimum of 12 post-secondary education hours, and demonstrate financial need. *Minimum GPA is 2.50.*

Marshall E. Nemer Memorial Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled, non-traditional student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need.

Paducah River City BPW Scholarship

Available to a currently enrolled female student who is active in the workforce and returning to school after raising a family.

John T. Smith Scholarship

Available to an African-American student who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates financial need. Student must be a Kentucky resident and demonstrate involvement in extra-curricular activities. *NOTE: Minimum GPA is 2.50. Student must be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours.*

Williams-Wahl Scholarship

Available to a student who meets the scholarship criteria.
